

Several factors:


- Units: enhancement



Peer Mentor Program

- Students are the mentors
- 20 Super Mentors, 92Mentors, 350+ Mentees

Fewer transition issues

- From 54% in 2015 to 15%
- Significantly lower in 2016 than other faculties
