 - Highly diverse programming experience of intake
 - Challenging high achievers while scaffolding learning for those without any experience
 - 'Testing out' for exemption
 - Separating undergraduates from conversion masters
- Increasing demand for other introductory courses
 - Introduction to programming
 - Programming for all 1st year engineers
