- MOOCs and blended learning

The ALTA Executive will determine the allocation of funding, based on:

- The likelihood of outcomes being achieved based on the project description
- The potential of the project to attract further external funding
- How well the priority areas have been addressed
- How well the outcomes will benefit the ICT education sector
