 - Honours & masters (46)
 - PhD (35)
- Completed focus groups with PhD students

Initial results from surveys

Undergraduates (n = 69)

- NOT interested in research (n = 59)
 - Start earning \$ (58% strongly agree)
 - Tired of study (49%)
- Interested in research (n = 10)
 - Invent/create/discover (60% strongly agree)
 - Lecturer demonstrated relevance to real life (50%)

Hons/masters (n = 46)

- NOT continuing into research (n = 31)
 - Start earning \$ (61% strongly agree)
 - Tired of study (40% strongly agree)
- Continuing into research (n = 15)
 - Want to find out more (67% strongly agree)
 - Want to invent/create/discover (60% strongly agree)

Initial results from surveys

Undergraduates (n = 69)
